

SoyBooru Management

Board config:

This is the panel for managing SoyBooru, I highly advise against messing with it, since many options may seem appealing but will end up breaking the site. Most of the options are self explanatory, but the only one that you might have to update is the banned phrases list, it mostly includes advertising keywords and commonly spammed comment thumbnails.

Bans:

There are two types of bans on SoyBooru. IP bans, and account bans.

IP bans have four options, these options are: *Block*, *Firewall*, *Ghost*, and *Anon-Ghost*.

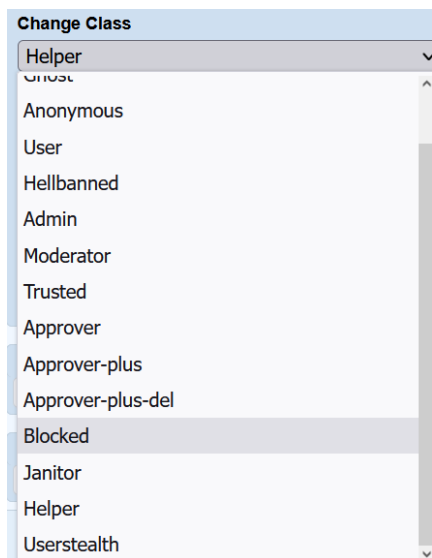
Block will prevent users from accessing the booru entirely, and will just show them a blank page with ban reason.

Firewall is the same as blocking, except that it will show a white page with no ban reason

Ghost is the recommended ban options, it will show ban reason at top of the page but will allow users to continue browsing the booru if they wish but without commenting/uploading.

Anon-Ghost is a shadow ban feature, it won't show that you're banned but will throw errors when you comment/upload.

Account bans can be issued by administrators only, if you wish to ban a user then go to his account and change his class to “Blocked”.



Hash bans:

You can ban specific hashes if you want by specifying deletion reason.

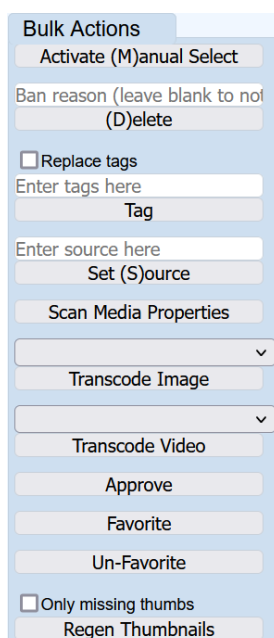
Extensions list:

Aliases, Autotags, and Untags:

Self explanatory, can be accessed by clicking on tags. Only admins and moderators can edit those.

Bulk Actions:



A powerful option that allows you to do multiple actions to all images in a specific search query or images that you select yourself, but can be dangerous and wipe the entire booru!

Only moderators+ have access to this.
