


# SoyBooru Chores

## Trash:

By default, images that mods/jannies deleted won't be deleted forever, and can be checked by administration before being removed from servers.

You can check for images that were deleted in approval queue by typing ".tu" in search bar, and you can check for images that were deleted after being approved by clicking "Trash" on top or searching for ".t" in the search bar.


If you wish to clean up the trash, simply click on (D)elete, but make sure that you typed the correct search terms otherwise you could wipe the entire booru!



## Setting tags to lowercase:

You can do this once every few months, since uppercase tags are prioritized, we need to set them all to lowercase every once in a while.

To do that either go to *System->Board Admin* or <https://booru.soy/admin> , and



## Checking for tag vandalism:

This is a task that janitors should do, they can check for vandalism by checking global tag history at [https://booru.soy/tag\\_history/all/1](https://booru.soy/tag_history/all/1) , or searching for posts with 3 tags or less by typing *tags<3* in the search bar.

## **Backups:**

I recommend that you do a backup every once in a while.

There are regular database backups located at /www/backup/path , these backups happen every 10 minutes and last 24 hours only. These backups do NOT include images, and are only helpful in the case of a comment/tags wipe.

If you wish to do a normal backup then do “sudo rsync -rt root@ 185.14.97.154:/var/www/wwwroot/booru.soy/ soybooru/” from your terminal

## **Logs cleanup:**

Logs can take up several GBs of storage, it's highly recommended to remove them periodically.

You can remove them by doing “sudo rm -rf /www/wwwlogs/ booru.soy.log”, since storage is quite low right now this is important.

Please note that when removing files from GUI, there's a recycle bin folder, you will have to cleanup that too. This is why it's advisable to use the command instead.

## **Locking comments:**

Sometimes you might want to lock comments of certain posts due to spam or other reasons, to do that go to

“/var/www/wwwroot/booru.soy/ext/comment/main.php”, at line 630 and add two vertical lines (||) and the desired post id in quotation marks, I think you should know how to do that by yourself.
